### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Salary of Adjutant-General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 25, amended. Section 25 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 25. The adjutant-general. The adjutant-general shall receive an annual salary of four thousand dollars \$5,000; he shall receive no other fee, emolument, or perquisite.'
