RESOLVE, Relative to Catching Lobsters Near Monhegan.

Repeal of rule and regulation numbered 76. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to repeal rule and regulation numbered 76, which relates to catching lobsters near Monhegan, as it appears in the official rules and regulations of the department, which was authorized by chapter 91 of the resolves of 1941.
