AN ACT Relating to Lands Owned by the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Supervision and control of certain state lands. All lands owned by the state of Maine, the management and control of which is not otherwise provided for by law, shall be under the joint supervision and control of, and shall be administered by a board composed of the state forest commissioner, the state tax assessor, and the attorney-general; and the said board shall have full power in the control and management of the same. The board shall have the power to sell and convey by competitive bids, after public notice, the growth on said lands and all or any part of said lands, and the proceeds of sale shall be transferred to the general funds of the state.
