STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Outside Work for Inmates of the State Reformatory for Men.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Inmates of the state reformatory for men permitted to work outside. The superintendent of the state reformatory for men may, in his discretion, allow any inmate of said institution to work outside of the premises of the institution during the present war emergency, and any earnings for such work shall be held by the superintendent and turned over to such inmate upon his release from the custody of the institution.
