STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Appropriations by Towns for Salaries of Superintendents of Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 19, § 67, amended. Section 67 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 67. Appropriation for salary of superintendent. Towns shall appropriate for the salary of the superintendent of schools their proportion of the sum paid said superintendent to the amount certified by the joint committee to the town treasurer, and said proportion to be paid by any town may be paid out of an appropriation for the salaries of town officers or out of a special appropriation for the purpose or out of an appropriation for the town's contingent or miscellaneous account, or by a combination of these methods, but it shall not be paid from any appropriation made for the support or maintenance of common schools or high schools. The proportion of the sum thus paid said superintendent shall be included as a part of the cost of education in said towns.'
