**AN ACT Relating to the Compensation of the Justices of the Supreme
and Superior Courts.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 3, amended. The 1st sentence of section 3 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'The justices of the supreme judicial court shall each receive an annual salary of ~~eight thousand dollars~~ \$10,000, and the chief justice of the supreme judicial court shall receive an annual salary of ~~nine thousand dollars~~ \$11,000.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 125, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'**Sec. 4. The superior courts.** Each of the justices of the superior court shall receive an annual salary of ~~seven thousand five hundred dollars~~ \$9,500. All provisions of the preceding section relating to reimbursement of justices of the supreme judicial court for expenses incurred by them shall apply to justices of the superior court, except that justices of the superior court shall not be entitled to reimbursement for expenses incurred in employing clerical assistance.'
