STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Commissioner of Insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 16. The insurance department. The insurance commissioner shall receive an annual salary of \$2,500 \$5,000.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 125, § 33, amended. Section 33 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 33. The industrial accident commission. The chairman of the industrial accident commission shall receive an annual salary of \$4,500, and the other commissioners an annual salary of \$4,000 each. The commissioner of labor and industry, in addition to his salary as such, shall receive for his services as a member of the commission \$2,000 annually. The commissioner of insurance, for his services as a member of the commission, shall receive the additional sum of \$1,500 annually. The members of the commission shall also receive their actual, necessary, cash expenses while away from their office on official business of the commission.'
