**RESOLVE, Providing for Construction of a Building for Employees at
the Pownal State School.**

**Construction of building at Pownal State School; appropriation for.
Resolved:** That the sum of \$50,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated for
the construction of a building for employees at the Pownal State School.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The matter of providing suitable quarters for male attendants and married employees has become very urgent. Some of the employees of the institution are located in the basement of the hospital. This is not a good arrangement; furthermore, these rooms are needed for hospital purposes. There are about 35 employees, many of them married, now living in what is known as the Shailer House, and part of this building was originally a horse barn, and was renovated some years ago to be used as employees' quarters. The building is a bad fire hazard. It is almost impossible to heat it and it has been repeatedly condemned by architects, and insurance under-writers.
