#### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Weight of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 56, amended. The 1st sentence of section 56 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'No motor truck, trailer, tractor, combination of truck tractor and semi-trailer or other commercial vehicle shall be operated over any way or bridge when the gross weight (actual weight of vehicle and load) exceeds \$\frac{1}{40},000\$ 50,000 pounds.'
