## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Permitting Bowling on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 135, § 39, amended. Section 39 of chapter 135 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'; or to the operation of bowling alleys, or bowling therein from 2 P. M. to 11 P. M..'
