STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Disposal of Confiscated Ammunition and Small Arms.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Disposal of confiscated ammunition and small arms. The state police, the department of inland fisheries and game, the sheriff of any county, and the police department of any city are hereby empowered to deliver, without charge, to Ordnance Department, Supply Branch, First Service Command, United States Army, all small arms and ammunition now held by them and which have been confiscated for violation of law.
