STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Treasurer of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 125, § 14, amended. Section 14 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 14. The state treasury. The treasurer of state shall receive an annual salary of \$3,000 \$4,000; he shall receive no other fee, emolument, or perquisite.

The chief clerk in the office of the treasurer of state shall be designated as "Deputy Treasurer of State."
