AN ACT Relating to Automobile Travel by State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1939, c. 220, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 220 of the public laws of 1939, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Payment per mile for use of privately owned automobiles, regulated. The state shall hereafter pay for the use of privately owned automobiles for travel by employees of the state in the business of the state not more than 5c per mile for the first ~~3,000~~ 15,000 miles actually travelled by such employees on such business in any 1 fiscal year, not more than 4c for each mile exceeding ~~3,000~~ 15,000, provided, however, that the state shall pay inspectors of seed potatoes 5c for every mile so travelled.'
