**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Institutional Service to
Transfer Certain Land.**

**Commissioner of institutional service authorized to transfer land. Re-
solved:** That the commissioner of institutional service, with the approval
of the governor and council, be, and hereby is, authorized to quitclaim to
Clarence Hawkes, of South Windham, for the sum of \$75, a piece of land
on the northwest corner of the property of the state reformatory for men,
described as follows:

From the southeasterly point of land now owned by Mr. Hawkes
bounded and described as follows: from that point northwesterly for 100
feet along property now owned by Mr. Hawkes; thence northeasterly for
200 feet along land now owned by Warren Dolly and the Androscoggin
Pulp Company; thence 100 feet southeasterly along property now owned
by the State Reformatory for Men and thence southwesterly 200 feet, to
the starting point.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This parcel is of no particular value to the state and is contiguous to the property of Mr. Hawkes.
