#### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses of Maintaining County Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 56, amended. Section 56 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Provided, however, that in deorganized towns, an assessment may be made of over 2% of the valuation thereof, if the state highway commission approves; in which case, the amount over the 2% shall be paid by the state out of the general highway fund.'
