### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Commissioner of Labor and Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 20, amended. Section 20 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 20. The department of labor and industry. The commissioner of labor and industry and state factory inspector shall receive an annual salary of two thousand dollars \$5,000; the commissioner and the deputy state factory inspector shall also receive their actual traveling expenses.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 125, § 33, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 33 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
