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**AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Commissioner of Labor and Industry.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 20, amended.** Section 20 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 20. The department of labor and industry.** The commissioner of labor and industry and state factory inspector shall receive an annual salary of ~~two thousand dollars~~ **\$5,000**; the commissioner and the deputy state factory inspector shall also receive their actual traveling expenses.'

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 125, § 33, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 33 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
