AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 125, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 13. The state department. The secretary of state shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$4,000~~ \$5,000. He and his deputy shall also receive such actual traveling expenses incident to the administration of his department as shall be necessary.'
