#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Permitting Employees of the Public School System to Obtain Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 19, § 228, subsection (1), amended. Subsection (1) of section 228 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- '(1) "Teacher" shall mean any teacher, principal, supervisor, school nurse, school secretary, or superintendent employed in any day school within the state; also a teacher or principal of a normal school, the commissioner of education or his assistants, and teachers who teach in any school which is supported at least 3/5 by state or town appropriations. Provided, however, that janitors of public schools, and school-bus operators shall be entitled to the same privileges and benefits as teachers under the teachers' retirement system.'
