RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Sabbath Day Lake, in New Gloucester.

Fishing in Sabbath Day lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting plug fishing for all fish, and the dipping for smelts in Sabbath Day lake, in the town of New Gloucester in Cumberland county, at any time.

Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 785, "Resolve Relating to Fishing in Sabbath Day lake, in New Gloucester."

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 4th from the last line thereof the following underlined words:

'plug fishing'

and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words:

"the use of live bait"
