### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Fees Allowed Under the Tax Lien Law, So-called.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 244, § 1, amended. The last sentence of section I of chapter 244 of the public laws of 1933, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The fees to be charged to the taxpayer and allowed to the officer afore-said shall be as follows:

- \$2 for making the 10-day notice; and 10c per mile for travel in case of service by hand or at last and usual place of abode, or in case the service is made by mailing by registered mail the actual postage expense.
- \$2 for making out the lien to be recorded in the registry of deeds, and 25c for each notice to a mortgage holder, and the actual expenses necessary to send out the forms and record them.

The register of deeds shall receive 75c for the recording of such lien.'
