**AN ACT Placing Officers and Employees of the Legislature under the
Provisions of the Contributory Retirement System.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 227-D, amended. Section 227-D of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, as amended by chapter 328 of the public laws of 1941, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following paragraph to be designated as subsection (8):

‘(8) Anything to the contrary notwithstanding, any officer or employee of the legislature who becomes a member of this system is hereby granted 2 years of creditable service for each term served and the compensation received by such officer or employee for such service shall be deemed the annual compensation rate for purposes of retirement.’
