STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Androscoggin County.

Fishing in Androscoggin county regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed and authorized to issue a rule and regulation opening all waters in Androscoggin county to fishing at all times for the duration of the war with Germany and Japan.
