## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Legal Notices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Addresses of defendants and respondents to be on writs and complaints. Writs in civil actions and complaints and warrants issued in criminal cases shall contain the name, street and town address of the defendant or respondent, if the complainants or the court are cognizant of the same.
