# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Hunting and Trapping of Foxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Hunting and trapping of foxes, regulated. For a period of 2 years from the effective date of this act, it shall be lawful to trap and dig out foxes at any time, and to hunt foxes at any time, except Sunday, in organized territory in this state, subject to the provisions of sections 42 and 50 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised.
- Sec. 2. Amending clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are suspended for the period of 2 years from the effective date of this act. All rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions herewith are hereby suspended for the period of 2 years from the effective date of this act.
