RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Mud Pond in the Town of Peru.

**Ice fishing for pickerel in Mud pond in town of Peru permitted: Re-
solved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby
is, directed and authorized to issue a rule and regulation opening Mud pond
in the town of Peru to ice fishing for pickerel only.

Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 1101, "Resolve Relating to Ice
Fishing in Mud Pond in the Town of Peru."

Amend said bill by striking out in the last line thereof the following
underlined word:

'only'

and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words:

"hornpout, white perch, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs, and smelts."
