RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Dyer's Long Pond, in Jefferson.

Dyer's Long pond opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed and authorized to issue a rule and regulation opening Dyer's long pond in the township of Jefferson, Lincoln county, to ice fishing under the general law.
