STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of Probate for Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 39, amended. The 4th line of section 39 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin, sixteen hundred dollars \$3,000,'
