STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to the Dipping of Alewives in Machias River.

Dipping of alewives in Machias river; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting the dipping of alewives with a hand net in the waters of Machias river below and easterly of an imaginary line across said river, which said line begins at a point on the northerly bank of said river, directly southeasterly from the southeasterly corner of the grist mill building commonly known as the Getchell Grist Mill, and extending southerly therefrom to an iron bolt on the opposite and southerly bank of said river.
