STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Emblems Designating the Members of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Secretary of state to prepare suitable emblems for members of the legislature. The secretary of state, immediately after the determination of the election of the senators and representatives to the legislature, shall prepare suitable emblems for the said senators and representatives.
