RESOLVE, Relating to Old Legislative Publications.

Librarian authorized to remove certain documents and records. Resolved: That the librarian of the Maine state library is hereby authorized to remove from the library reserve any excess copies of printed senate and house journals, legislative documents and legislative records, and to make such disposition of them as may seem proper: provided, however, that a sufficient number of each publication shall be retained to take care of the needs of the library and the legislature.
