STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fire Protection for Baxter State Park.

Appropriation for fire protection of Baxter State Park. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,506 per year to be paid into the Maine Forestry District Fund to be used for the protection of Baxter State Park from fire.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The average cost per acre for fire protection in the Maine Forestry District is .0133 per acre. About 113,000 acres are exempted from taxation because they are in, or proposed to be in the Baxter State Park. This appropriation is necessary to cover the cost to the state.
