STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Taxation of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 12, § 90, amended. Section 90 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following:

'No motor truck or trailer having a rated carrying capacity of more than $r^{1/2}$ tons, travelling in this state only in interstate commerce, and owned in a state wherein an excise or property tax shall have been paid on said vehicle, and which grants to Maine owned trucks and trailers the exemption herein contained shall be subject to this excise.'
