STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse H. W. Brooks, of Portland.

H. W. Brooks; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$36.30 to be paid in favor of H. W. Brooks, of Portland, Maine, to reimburse him for an over-payment of his gasoline tax; said sum to be paid from the Aeronautical Gas Tax Appropriation.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

On March 15, 1942, Mr. Brooks forwarded a rebate to the state on gasoline purchased from the Valvoline Oil Company. It appears that the letter was lost in the mail and the claim was not received by the state in time to allow the rebate.
