STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Throwing of Bottles, Etc. on the Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 26, additional. Chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 5-A, and to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 5-A. Whoever throws or deposits on any public way or on land within the bounds of such way any bottles or metal cans, except in proper containers placed for rubbish collection and removal, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$10.'
