STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Notices of Changes of Locations of Certain Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Municipal officers to notify county commissioners when location of certain highways is changed. Whenever the location of any state aid or third class highway is changed, added to, discontinued, or a new location is established by a town or city, the municipal officers of said town or city shall notify the county commissioners of the county of which said town or city is a part, of such change with an accurate description of the courses and distances, within 3 months from such action.
- Sec. 2. County commissioners to notify state highway commission when location of certain highways is changed. Whenever the location of any state, state aid, or third class highway is changed, added to, discontinued, or a new location is established within a county, the county commissioners of said county shall place on file the description of such change, and shall notify the state highway commission of such change with an accurate description of the courses and distances within I year from such action. Provided, however, that whenever the state highway commission has previous record of such action, no notification by the county commissioners to the state highway commission shall be deemed necessary.
