STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Recorder of the Waldo County
Municipal Court and to Provide for Clerk Hire.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 12, § 2, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 2 of chapter 12 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Said judge shall receive a salary of \$1,400 per year and said recorder shall receive a salary of \$600 \$700 per year for all services in criminal and civil cases, said salary to include whatever clerk hire he may deem necessary to hire for the proper performance of his duties, to be paid from the treasury of the county of Waldo in monthly payments on the 1st day of each month.'
