### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Providing for the Maintenance of the Road Leading to Baxter State Park.

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, former Governor Baxter has given a large area of land to the state of Maine; and

Whereas, there is only one road leading to Baxter state park; and

Whereas, the road leading to said park will be in need of immediate repair after the spring rains; and

Whereas, if this maintenance is not provided for immediately, the road will not be passable and the value and use of Governor Baxter's gift will be depreciated; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maintenance of road to Baxter state park provided for. The state highway commission is hereby authorized and directed to expend on the unim2

proved portion of the Baxter state park road, so called, as much as shall be deemed necessary for its maintenance, but not to exceed \$2,500 per year. Those portions, however, for which state aid may be available are excepted from the provisions of this act.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
