RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Bethel.

Town of Bethel; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$225 to be paid to the town of Bethel, to compensate said town for services of the Bethel fire department in fighting a forest fire in Albany, a deorganized town; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This forest fire occurred in June, 1941. The fire department of Bethel was called by R. G. Wardwell, a state agent, to fight the forest fire in Albany, a deorganized town. The town of Bethel has not been compensated for its expenses.
