RESOLVE, Granting Authority to the Forest Commissioner to Cancel
Deed Erroneously Recorded

Forest commissioner authorized to cancel certain deed. Resolved: That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to cancel deed to said commissioner to certain lot reputed to be owned by Herbert E. Robbins, with the buildings thereon, near center of said township bounded north, east, and west by land owned by F. W. Robbins; south by the Cherryfield road, not including small lot owned by Merton H. Leighton, containing 5.50 acres, in Township 10, S. D., Hancock County, as recorded in State Land Office Volume 5, Page 190 in record of deeds of lands sold for taxes.

The 1941 tax assessed against the above described property and amounting to \$16.31 is hereby abated.
