RESOLVE, in Relation to Status of Paul J. Brown in Re Teachers' Retirement Association.

Credit given to Paul J. Brown for service at East Maine Conference Seminary. Resolved: That Paul J. Brown of Bucksport, Maine be permitted to make his membership in the Maine Teachers' Retirement Association retroactive to cover 5 years of service renderd in East Maine Conference Seminary, a private institution, by making required contributions plus interest accumulation, which shall give him full standing in said association.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Brown held the position of history teacher and athletic director at Bucksport Seminary, (East Maine Conference Seminary) from the summer of 1928 until June, 1933 with the exception of 1 year. During those years no deductions were made for the Maine State Teachers' pension. It is important that these years be added to Mr. Brown's credit.
