STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for the Retirement of Certain Hancock-Sullivan Bridge Bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Retirement of certain Hancock-Sullivan bridge bonds, provided for. The state shall pay to the treasurer of Hancock county each year, out of the general highway funds, such sums as shall be necessary to retire maturing bonds together with interest on Hancock-Sullivan bridge bonds, and such sums are hereby appropriated.
