RESOLVE, Relating to Retirement Pension for Ralph M. Chesley, of Thomaston.

Retirement pension for Ralph M. Chesley. Resolved: That Ralph M. Chesley, of Thomaston, overseer in the upholstery shop at the Maine State Prison, is hereby made eligible to receive a retirement pension under the provisions of section 227-C of chapter 328 of the public laws passed at the special session of the legislature in January, 1942.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

The provisions for membership in the system did not cover the case of Mr. Chesley.
