RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Newry for Bounty Paid.

Town of Newry; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of the town of Newry, the sum of \$10 to reimburse said town for bounty on bear paid to Fred W. Wight, of Newry; said sum to be paid from the dog license fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state did not pay this bounty because more than 24 hours had elapsed between the killing of the bear and the time the claim was executed, and this is to reimburse the town of Newry for same.
