STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for Construction of a Building for Employees at the Pownal State School.

Construction of building at Pownal State School; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$100,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated out of the sinking fund reserve for the construction of a building for employees at the Pownal State School. This appropriation shall not lapse and shall be carried forward from year to year until such time that the building is constructed. The construction of the building shall begin as soon as practical, contingent upon the availability of materials and labor.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is necessary to provide for the housing of 50 or more employees at Pownal State School as soon as possible. This bill will permit the state to proceed on the building as soon as materials are available.
