IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR

RESOLVE, Providing for Certain Construction of Fish Hatcheries and Rearing Stations.

Fish hatcheries and rearing stations; construction of. Resolved: That the sum of \$200,000 be and hereby is appropriated to the department of inland fisheries and game out of the amount set aside in the general fund as a Maine Postwar Public Works Reserve, for the construction of two hatchery and rearing station combinations, at suitable points in the state where proper waters are available.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is necessary to provide for the construction of the hatchery and rearing stations as soon as materials and labor are available.
