### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Members of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Salary of members of legislature. Each member of the senate and house of representatives shall receive \$1,200 for the regular session of the legislature.
- Sec. 2. Salary of president of the senate and speaker of the house of representatives. The president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives shall each receive \$1,400 for each regular session of the legislature, with the same mileage as the other members and subject to the same deduction in case of absence.
- Sec. 3. Salary during extra sessions. When an extra session is called by the governor, the members of the senate and house of representatives shall each be paid \$10 for every day's attendance and mileage as provided by law.
- Sec. 4. Inconsistent legislation repealed or amended. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed or amended to conform herewith.
