IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Completion of the Eighth Revision of the Public Laws.

Completion of revision of statutes. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$15,000 to complete the purposes of the provisions of chapter 140 of the resolves of 1941 and chapter 38 of the resolves of 1943 for the completion of the 8th revision of the public laws. Any unexpended balance left after the final completion of the revision shall lapse to the general fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The complete printing, binding and publishing costs will be approximately \$12,000 more than was originally estimated. The difference in cost has been brought about because there will be at least 33% more pages than was first anticipated and there will be a 2-volume edition instead of one.
