IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-FOUR

AN ACT Authorizing the Withholding of the Federal Income Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Purpose. In order to cooperate with the federal government, it is the purpose of this act to give to the federal government a temporary grant and not to relinquish any rights of the state of Maine.

Sec. 2. Withholding of federal income tax. The federal income tax, so called, shall be deducted from the salaries and wages of all state, county and municipal officials and employees. The treasurer of state, the several county treasurers, and the treasurers of the several municipalities shall act as custodians of such moneys and pay them over to the collector of internal revenue as required by federal law.
