AN ACT Increasing the Salaries of the Members of the Industrial
Accident Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 29, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 29 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The chairman shall receive a salary of ~~\$4,500~~ \$6,500 per year, and the other commissioners a salary of ~~\$4,000~~ \$6,000 each per year. The commissioner of labor and industry, in addition to his salary as such, shall receive for his services as a member of the commission \$1,000 per year. The members of the commission shall also receive their actual, necessary, cash expenses while away from their office on official business of the commission.'
